Y partnership with the Boys and Girls Club of Greater Milwaukee

As a leader in swim education, the Milwaukee Y teaches more than 9,000 children and adults to swim each year. The Centers for Disease Control and Prevention has warned that drowning is one of the top three causes of unintentional injury death for people 29 and younger, and for African-American children aged 5 to 19, the drowning rate is five times that of white children. Nationally, 70% of African-American children, 58% of Hispanic children and 40% of white children have little or no swimming ability and are at risk of water-related injury or death. The Y's "Milwaukee Swims" partnership with the Boys and Girls Club of Greater Milwaukee will bring affordable swim lessons to more sites throughout the city in an effort to help reverse these preventable and troubling trends.
