- Position:** Aquatic Instructors (PT)
- Locations:** Northside, Rite-Hite, & Northwest YMCAs
- Reports to:** Aquatic Director & Aquatic Manager
- Wage Range:** \$7.25- \$8.80 per hour (depending on certification & experience)

Major Responsibilities:

- Conduct swim classes in accordance with Y of the USA's Swimming Lesson Program in an enthusiastic and exciting way
- Teach all levels of swimming and maximize swimmer participation of every class period
- Complete and turn in all participant paperwork as required by supervisor
- Communicate student progress to participants and/or their parents throughout the session
- Work to build meaningful relationships with participants and their families
- Maintain a positive and responsible attitude and demeanor at all times, as well as a genuine spirit of silliness and creativity that will provide participants with a sense of wonder and happiness at every lesson

Qualifications:

- Must be able to pass a swimming skills test, which includes a 300yd swim, (with proper demonstration of all required strokes) 3 minutes of treading water, and retrieval of a 10 pound weight from the pool bottom.
- Preference given to candidates with American Red Cross Water Safety Instructor or YMCA Swim Lesson Certifications.
- Depending on experience the Milwaukee YMCA may require co-teaching with current instructors.
 - The Milwaukee YMCA will train candidates.
- Current certifications in CPR/AED for the Professional Rescuer, Administering Emergency Oxygen, and Standard First Aid preferred, but many be completed within 90 days of hire
- Must be able to teach in hot, humid environments
- Must be able to understand the mentality of children and adults of various ages and relate to them in a fun-loving, engaging, and captivating way
