Major Responsibilities:

- Strictly adhere and be accountable for the execution of all Association and Aquatics policies and procedures related to safety and conduct rules and other regulations
- Assist with the training of Aquatic staff in an effort to achieve the desired program outcomes including but not limited to assisting in running of aquatic in-services and new staff orientations
- Support the Aquatic Director of the Center, Aquatic staff, and programs by providing direction and support
- Act as Manager on Duty for the Northwest YMCA Facility. This includes On-deck supervision of staff during scheduled hours, serving as Waterfront Supervisor for various licenses camp groups, working with Aquatics Manager and Aquatics Director to develop Northwest YMCA staff schedule.
- This position may require up to 25 hours of teaching or lifeguarding each week as needed.
- Collect & secure daily cash intake from the center. Train lifeguard staff to assist with front desk duties when out of rotation.
- Ensure that care of members is a key priority through direct supervision of Aquatic staff in the absence of the Aquatic Director
- Cooperate with Center Leadership and staff to support excellence and consistency in service through care of members, program participants and volunteers
- Support quality program delivery through staff excellence in an effort to achieve programmatic outcomes
- Represent and articulate the Association's Aquatics mission and program to individuals, businesses and communities

Qualifications:

- Must have 2 years of college or a combination of education and experience
- Must have at least 1 year of aquatic supervisory experience with staff/volunteers and programs, and minimum of 2-3 years of successful Aquatic work experience that includes instructional, lifeguarding or specialty aquatic activities is required
- Current certifications in CPR/AED for the Professional Rescuer, Administering Emergency Oxygen, and Standard First Aid required
- Proven ability to display initiative, good judgment and ability to make decisions with minimal input.
- Ability to coordinate and prioritize multiple tasks in a fast paced environment with interruptions
- Leadership skills, self-driven, detail oriented, and capable of dealing with department issues effectively
- Must demonstrate excellent computer (Windows Office and Daxko) skills, as well as, written and verbal communication skills
