#### Major Responsibilities:

- Ensures that daily care of members is a key priority by providing center supervision, leadership, support and direction to center staff and guests.
- Facilitate prospective member tours as needed.
- Collaborate with Center Leadership and staff to ensure excellence and consistency in security and prompt service through daily care of members, program participants and volunteers.
- Diligently monitor facility for safety and service interventions; serve as first responder.
- Perform light housekeeping and maintenance as necessary.
- Maintain and evaluate safety protocol and communicate with Member Engagement Director regarding systematic approaches for continual improvement.
- Responsible for strict adherence to all Center policies and procedures with particular attention on safety and professional conduct.

- Must be 21 or older with a high school education or equivalent
- Minimum 2 years demonstrated experience in active listening, critical thinking, social perceptiveness, and judgment and independent decision making and customer service
- Must be able to stand and walk a minimum of 5 hours; including frequent stair climbing
- Must be able to ensure essential duties are performed within Y and on Y property including parking lot, year round
- Must be able to lift up to 50 pounds
- Must be able to gain and maintain and administer CPR for the professional rescuer, AED, 02, and First Aid
- Must be able to remain calm under pressure; resolve conflict professionally
- Ability to direct and coordinate emergency procedures
- Proven ability to display initiative, good judgment and ability to make decisions independently
- Demonstrated written and verbal communication skills; ability to communicate and relate to all age groups and backgrounds
- High level of knowledge and demonstrated competence in the areas of safety and guest relations
