- Support the creation and execution of developmentally appropriate activities that focus on out-of-doors, nature, science, etc. for children ages 3-5 yrs
- Must have knowledge of environmental education, nature programming and be able to lead and instruct preschool children outdoors (for 2 hours per day) during school year (rain, snow, shine)
- Support implementation and maintenance of appropriate nature based curriculum and activities utilizing blended curriculum (Creative Curriculum, Project Learning Tree, etc.) and other classroom/environmental tools
- Administer the Early Childhood Education Program in accordance with the WI Department of Children and Family (DCF 251) rules and regulations related to the care of children
- Ensure that care of program participants and staff is a key priority with excellent customer service and communication while maintaining professional and organized center atmospheres.
- Teach in classroom up to 25 hours per week as ECE Nature Preschool Teacher
- Provide administrative and program support; maintain accurate records for attendance, reports, and children's records that are in compliance with DCF and association policies and procedures
- Support quality program delivery through staff excellence in an effort to achieve the desired program outcomes; maintain required current certifications

Perform all other duties as assigned by supervisor

Qualifications:

- A Bachelor's Degree in Early Childhood Education or Environmental Education or related field is preferred.
- Must be at least 21 years of age and possess a high school diploma or equivalent.
 - a. Required Trainings: Provided by the YMCA-CPR-Pro, AED, and First Aid Certification Shaken Baby Syndrome and SIDS.
- At least 80 hours of approved Early Childhood classes with documentation OR completed at least 6 credits in elementary education, child guidance, child development or other approved courses OR have a bachelor's degree in education, social work, child development, child psychology or other related field.
- Must have 2 years previous experience working with children in a formal setting; minimum of 1 years supervisory experience or administration preferred.
- Proven ability to manage multiple priorities, have initiative, good judgment, and ability to work independently, strong interpersonal skills with excellent written and oral communication skills.
- Competent computer skills necessary to perform job; Microsoft Office experience preferred
