- Assist the director in the overall development of the School Age Education and Day Camp Programs
- Ensure that the care of the participants is a key priority through direct supervision of the School Age and Day Camp Programs; be in ratio as needed
- Supervise and support staff in the absence of the Direct; monitor staff and child files for region
- Demonstrate a positive and caring attitude with children, staff, parents, and community members
- Understand and follow all state DCF Child Care and Day Camp licensing standards, Youngstar, and YMCA policies/manuals
- Attend and assist in planning and leading staff meetings, training sessions, other required meetings and evaluation of staff members
