They will also serve as the principal liaison and relationship builder with center staff, program staff, as well as members and community organizations to continue to increase program growth and development while maintaining program participant satisfaction.

Responsibilities:

- Ensures that high quality program activity is the first priority through supervision of center staff.
- Collaborate with Core Service VP's (Membership, Program, Wellness Centers / Facility) and Core Service leaders and staff to ensure consistent excellence in service through daily care of members, program participants and volunteers.
- Must understand and support program objectives and expected outcomes.
- Assist in the development and maintenance of relationships with diverse community leaders as a basis for identification/implementation of responsive programs for communities served.
- Role Model strong fiscal stewardship and assist center program staff to meet or exceed program budget goals.
- Execute the total program experience by leading a high-performing team of staff and volunteers focused on relationship building, member & program participant involvement and satisfaction.
- Responsible for other duties and projects as necessary to achieve goals and priorities of the Association.
- Responsible for strict adherence to all policies and procedures related to safety and conduct rules and other regulations.

Qualifications:

The position requires a Bachelor's degree, or equivalent education/experience with a minimum of 3 years of successful management and supervisory experience. Leadership experience in the areas of volunteer and staff development, budget and fiscal management; and community development.
