THE PLAN

- More inviting, tree-filled camp arrival
- Easier, more intuitive camp pick-up/drop-off
- New traffic loop

THE IMPACT

- Creates a welcoming first impression and sets the tone for a great camp experience in a natural setting
- Increases safety and security
- Increases parking capacity

- Build new KYBOs in Girls, Boys and Explorers Unit

THE IMPACT

- Increase capacity to serve all campers efficiently
- Improve infrastructure to keep up with the next century of camp



NEW CABINS



THE PLAN

- Replace existing yurts with 6 winterized cabins

THE IMPACT

- Increase capacity to serve campers year-round, allowing us to double the number of campers in the Explorer area
- Build capacity and infrastructure for the next century of campers



DOWNTOWN CAMP



THE PLAN

- New central commons area
- New sports court
- Renovate Council Bluff

THE IMPACT

- Create spaces that will serve as the core of camp
- Allows campers to gather for programming, recreation, and bonding
- Host creative performances and all-camp gatherings that create lifelong memories
- Create strong linkage to new dining hall and other camp areas

- New, larger dining hall with enhanced lake views
