

## 24<sup>th</sup> Annual Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr. Celebration Event Frequently Asked Questions (FAQ's)

Thank you for registering for our virtual Dr. King Celebration. Our team has comprised a list of potential questions you may have as you prepare to join us on January 18, 2021.

Q: Can I still purchase tickets to join the event?

A: Yes, tickets can still be purchased for the event. You can visit our <u>registration page</u> for more information. We ask that you purchase your tickets no later than 4:00 p.m. Friday January 15, 2021.

Q: How many people can attend the event with my link?A: Each event link is customized for an individual. Please do not share it with others.

**Q:** I've registered for the event and cannot find the confirmation. Where can I look? **A:** Your registration links were provided to your organization contact. Please follow-up with them directly for more guidance. You should also check your junk or spam in the event it accidently went there.

Q: I noticed different start times for the event. What is the VIP reception?
A: We are hosting a VIP reception for all Support sponsors, which will include a moderated conversation between the Milwaukee County Executive David Crowley and
Metropolitan Milwaukee Area Commerce (MMAC) President & CEO Tim Sheehy that begins at 8:30 a.m. The reception will also include a welcome from our VIP and Deliberate Dialogue sponsor Potawatomi Bingo Casino President & CEO, Rodney Ferguson. The main event will begin promptly at 9:00 a.m.

**Q:** What do you recommend is the most optimal time to log in prior to the event start? **A:** We recommend that you log into the event at least 10 minutes prior to the start time (i.e- VIP reception- log in at 8:20 a.m.) to ensure you are able to get in. You will know that you are in the right place when you see "reception" landing page.

Q: Is there a place I should look for in the event I experience any technical difficulties?
A: We have partnered with Majic Productions and Hopin to steam this event. If you encounter login issues or steaming issues during the event you may contact : Majic

## Tips for Improved Steaming Experience:

 Registration Links: Your email address is linked to your own unique registration link. Your registration link cannot be used on multiple devices. Registration links are not able to be shared. Doing any of the aforementioned will impact your ability to access the 24<sup>th</sup> Annual Dr. Martin Luther King Jr. Celebration event experience.

## 2. Internet Connection:

- a. Only use Google Chrome or Mozilla Firefox when entering the event.
- b. Check your internet connection if there are periodic pauses during the event stream. Connection speed is generally the leading factor for unwanted pauses.
- c. Reduce the number of devices used on the interest. Multiple devices can slow the speed of your streaming devices video download speed. This can cause the video to stop and/or buffer.
- d. If streaming from home, position your streaming device (i.e., your phone, tablet, laptop, T.V.) closer to the router while viewing the event.
